Commitment to Achieving Net Zero

STORZ MEDICAL AG is committed to achieving Net Zero greenhouse gas emissions by **2050**.

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been prepared in accordance with UK Government Procurement Policy Note (PPN) 06/21 and the associated Technical Standard for the Completion of Carbon Reduction Plans.

The plan covers STORZ MEDICAL UK Ltd.'s activities within the UK.

Baseline Emissions Footprint

The baseline emissions represent the first complete year for which emissions were calculated.

The baseline year of 2025 represents STORZ MEDICAL UK's first complete greenhouse gas inventory prepared in accordance with the Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Protocol Corporate Standard. The inventory includes Scope 1, Scope 2, and the relevant Scope 3 emission categories required under PPN 006, together with additional Scope 3 categories where data are available. The baseline provides the reference against which future emissions reductions will be measured.

Current Emissions Reporting

As the baseline year (2025) is also the first reporting year, the current emissions are identical to the baseline emissions. Consequently, no year-on-year comparison or emissions reduction can yet be reported.

Future Carbon Reduction Plans will report annual progress against the 2025 baseline, demonstrating emissions reductions achieved through the implementation of the Company's carbon reduction initiatives and progress towards its Net Zero commitment.

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Emissions Reduction Targets

Our objective is to continuously reduce greenhouse gas emissions across our operations, specifically:

- Reduce total greenhouse gas emissions by 30% by 2040 (compared with the baseline year).
- Achieve 100% renewable electricity by 2040.
- Reduce business travel emissions through increased use of virtual meetings.
- Continue progress towards Net Zero by 2050.

Progress will be reviewed annually.

Carbon Reduction Projects and Future Initiatives

The following environmental measures have been implemented:

- Reduction of business travel through virtual meetings.
- Recycling and waste separation.
- Procurement of energy-efficient IT equipment.
- Sales and Services on durable products.
- Recyclable packaging is used whenever possible.

Future initiatives include:

- Increased use of remote and hybrid working.
- Increase the proportion of low-emission vehicles.
- Improve monitoring of Scope 3 emissions.

- Introduce further energy efficiency improvements.
- Continue annual carbon footprint assessments.



Methodology

Greenhouse gas emissions are calculated using the GHG Protocol Corporate Standard.

Activity data is collected from sources including:

- Electricity and gas invoices
- Total kilometers driven by all company vehicles
- Business travel records
- Waste contractor reports
- Employee commuting survey

The inventory follows the principles of the GHG Protocol.

As a medical device company operating under EU MDD- and MDR requirements, the organization recognizes that patient safety and regulatory compliance remain paramount. Environmental improvements are implemented without compromising product quality, safety or regulatory obligations.

Declaration and Signature

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with PPN 06/21 and associated guidance.

The emissions reported are considered accurate and represent the best available data at the time of publication.
